Next DOMS concert: **THE LAST WAR SONATA** (January 19)

Pianist **Fiona Wu** leads a journey through keyboard and piano masterworks, from the last composition by J. S. Bach to the last of Prokofiev's three "War Sonatas".

Jeff Rogers is a singer-songwriter from Ottawa. His influences include Ray Charles, Stevie Wonder, B.B. King, and Jamiroquai. After the release of his blues-inspired, self-titled debut album in 2007, Jeff appeared at numerous festivals opening for acts including Taj Mahal, Colin Linden, Sonny Landreth, and The Downchild Blues Band. Jeff released his second full-length album, *Let It Show*, in 2012 and his third is expected to be out by the end of 2022.



Jamie Holmes has been active in the Ottawa music scene for the past 14 years and is one of the most sought-after drummers in the area. With over 20 years of experience, Jamie can be

seen regularly working with numerous bands playing jazz, fusion, funk, blues, rock, pop, Latin, hip-hop and just about everything in between. Jamie's joy, passion, and creativity shine when he sits down at the kit.

Edward Lister is a UK-born trumpeter, composer and educator who has been playing professionally since the age of 15. With an honours degree in jazz performance and composition studies from Leeds College of Music (UK), he has been based out of Ottawa since 2011. He currently runs seven of his own ensembles, performs in a further fifteen, and has recorded on over thirty albums. Edward owns and operates the entertainment agency London Gentleman Records.



Born in Eastern Europe, brought up in the wilderness of the Great White North, and later thrust into the urban jungle of New York City, it is no surprise that **Petr Cancura's** musical palate is as wide as it is. The adventure continues with Cancura's position as the Programming Director of the Ottawa International Jazz Festival, crafting together a world-class festival with hundreds of shows annually. You may also find Cancura in the classroom giving workshops all across the US and Canada.
